

A new lineup of pamphlets aimed at overseas visitors

(Including information on the Ramen Battlegrounds and Kabukiza Theater)

On October 1, 2013, Tokyo Metro Co., Ltd (Head Office: Taito-ku, Tokyo, President: Yoshimitsu OKU) began distributing individual language versions of the Tokyo Metro Guide, a tourist pamphlet aimed at overseas visitors.

The Tokyo Metro Guide provides information about the range of tickets available to overseas visitors using the Tokyo Metro, as well as information about sightseeing spots along the Tokyo Metro line.

Previously the Tokyo Metro Guide was presented as a single pamphlet with the information in Japanese, English, Korean, and Chinese (Simplified & Traditional.) However, in order to make the guide as useful as possible to overseas visitors, we have now created individual language versions. In each language version of the pamphlet, we introduce different sightseeing spots around Tokyo to reflect the interests of our visitors, so the Chinese (Traditional) version has information on Shibuya and the Ramen Battlegrounds, whereas the English version has information on Kappa Bash and Kabukiza Theater. In addition to a Subway Route Map which shows all the subway stations, we have also included a new Tokyo Travel Map to make it easier for overseas visitors to navigate Tokyo's sightseeing spots.

Here at Tokyo Metro we hope to contribute to the continued development of Tokyo as a truly international city by supplying convenient and easy to follow information to overseas visitors to Tokyo.
