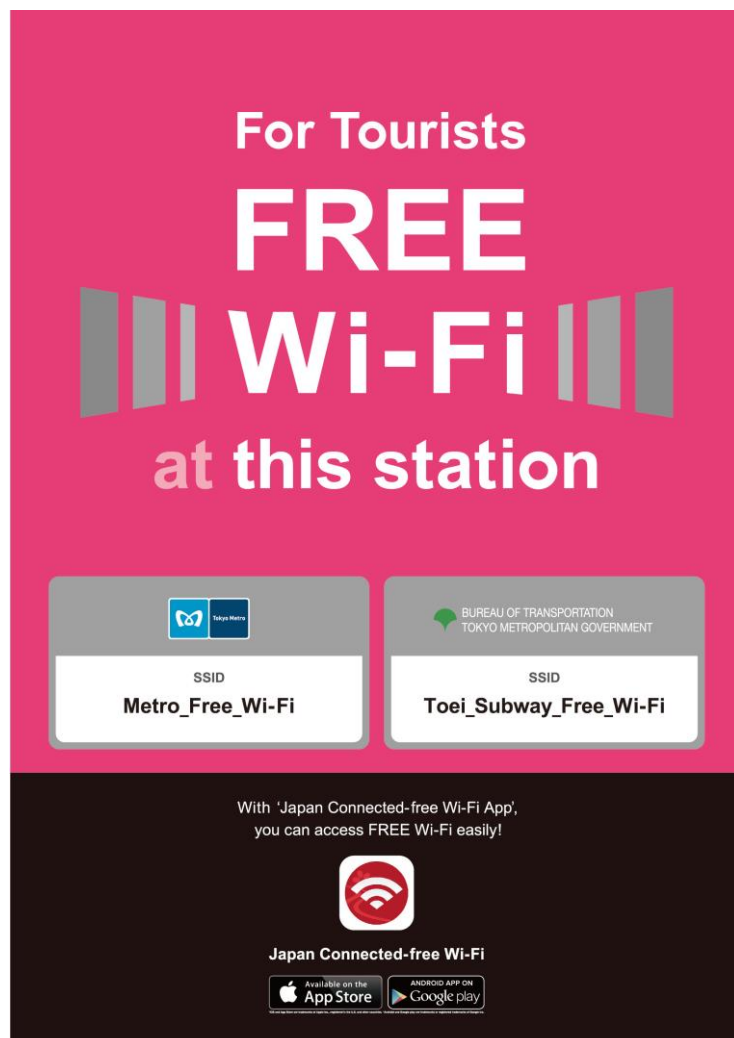

– Making travel around Tokyo easier and more convenient –
Free Wi-Fi for tourists available at 143 subway stations
in Tokyo from Monday, December 1!

With a view to the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and Paralympics, from Monday, December 1, 2014, Tokyo Metropolitan Bureau of Transportation and Tokyo Metro Co., Ltd. will offer a free Wi-Fi service at those subway stations which are expected to be used by a large number of visitors to Japan (143 stations in total).

Our free Wi-Fi service is also supported by the official *Japan Connected-free Wi-Fi* App offered by NTT Broadband Platform Inc. With this App, users register just once to enable them to easily use free Wi-Fi on Toei Subway and Tokyo Metro. Users can even continue to use the free Wi-Fi service when they transfer to a Toei Bus!

Details about Free Wi-Fi for Tourists

1. Service Start Date: Monday December 1, 2014

2. Service Details

- Coverage Area: 143 Tokyo Subway Stations (See Attachment 2)
- Usage Time: 3 hours/session (No limit to number of sessions)
- Network Name (SSID):
 Toei Subway Stations = Toei_Subway_Free_Wi-Fi
 Tokyo Metro Stations = Metro_Free_Wi-Fi
- Operator: NTT Broadband Platform Inc.

3. Supported by *Japan Connected-free Wi-Fi*

In addition to rolling out our free Wi-Fi service, Tokyo Metropolitan Bureau of Transportation and Tokyo Metro Co., Ltd have opted into the *Japan Connected-free Wi-Fi* service, an Android/iOS App offered by NTT Broadband Platform Inc. (NTTBP)

Using this App, users will be able to search for free Wi-Fi hot spots and access them in one easy step. As well as the hot spots offered by Toei Subway, Toei Bus, and Tokyo Metro, there are roughly 90,000 hot spots nationwide wherever NTTBP offer free Wi-Fi services, such as at major airports, main train stations and tourist facilities. The App also allows users to register once thus eliminating the need to log-in at each different Wi-Fi hot spot, making free Wi-Fi services easier and more convenient to use.
