**Adult ticket: 710yen → 600yen from Tuesday, February 10, 2015**

From **Tuesday, February 10, 2015, Tokyo Metro will reduce the price of the Tokyo Metro One-Day Open Ticket** (a ticket that enables visitors to enjoy a full day of unlimited rides on all Tokyo Metro lines.) **Adult tickets will drop from 710 yen to 600 yen and children's tickets will drop from 360 yen to 300 yen.**

The Tokyo Metro One-Day Open Ticket is perfect for sightseeing around Tokyo as you can get on or off the subway as many times as you like, allowing you to explore the various charms of each area. Why not enjoy a day sightseeing all over Tokyo using the new and even better value Tokyo Metro One-Day Open Ticket?

## Tokyo Metro One-Day Open Ticket Details (Valid from Tuesday, February 10, 2015)

### 1. Ticket Design

Adult: 600 yen      Child: 300 yen

All Tokyo Metro lines

### 4. Where to Buy

**Advance Purchase:** Tokyo Metro Ticket Counters (Excluding Nakano Station, Nishifunabashi Station, and Fukutoshin Line Shibuya Station.)

**Same-day Purchase:** Ticket vending machines in all Tokyo Metro Stations.

### 5. Valid Period

Advance Purchase: Good for one day of unlimited rides on a single day within the valid period marked on the ticket.

Same-day Purchase: Good for one day of unlimited rides on the day of purchase

### 6. Chikatoku Special Discount Guide

Enjoy special benefits such as discounts or complimentary gifts at 112 establishments and 443 tourist spots along the Tokyo Metro and Toei Subway lines upon presentation of a Tokyo Metro One-Day Open Ticket or other qualifying ticket.

### 7. Handling of One-Day Open Tickets purchased before the price change

One-Day Open Tickets (advance purchase) purchased on or before Monday, February 9, 2015 can

be exchanged for new One-Day Open Tickets between Tuesday, February 10, 2015 and Thursday, April 30, 2015 for a full refund of the difference without incurring a processing fee. However, please be aware that in the event that you are not exchanging your ticket and require a full refund of the ticket price, a processing fee of 220 yen shall be deducted.(In either case the tickets must be unused and still valid).
