Technical Maintenance	Lecture Site-visit	-Periodic inspections and maintenance based on technical standards for rolling stocks, infrastructure, and electrical facilities
Railway Facilities (Metro Museum)	Site-visit	-Tokyo Metro's history and construction technology -Efforts for ensuring that the subway run safely
Training Facilities / Drill	Lecture Site-visit	-Training utilizing the Comprehensive Learning and Training Center -Cross-departmental training for accident recovery
