Operation suspension schedule

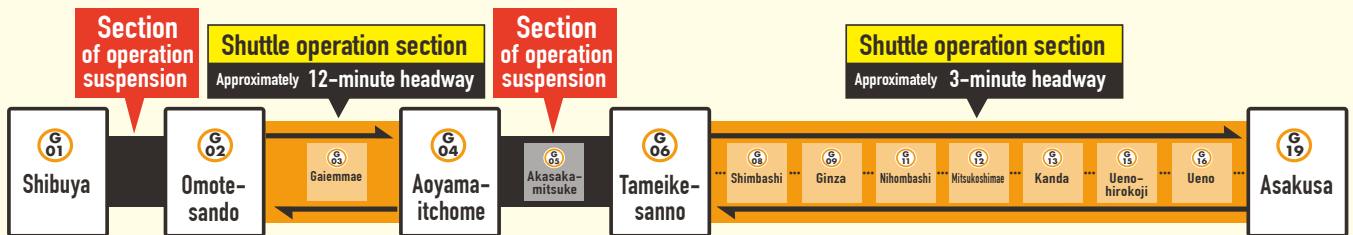

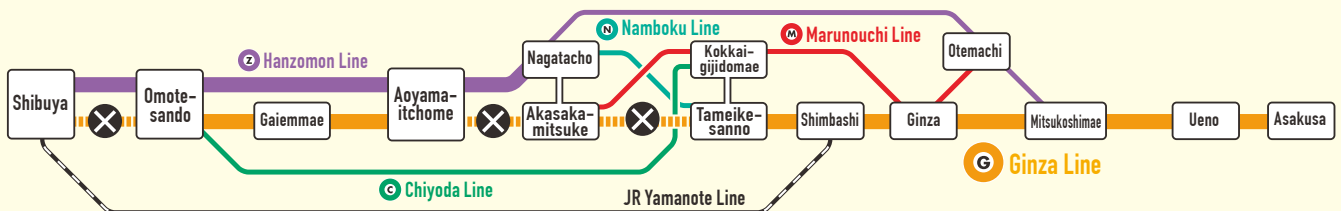
Sections of operation suspension

Ginza Line: Shibuya – Omote-sando, Aoyama-itchohome – Tameike-sanno



- On the days of construction work, shuttle operation will be carried out between Asakusa and Tameike-sanno, as well as short shuttle operation between Aoyama-itchohome and Omote-sando. Alternative transportation routes are available on all other Tokyo Metro lines, Toei subway lines, and some sections of JR lines and private railway lines.
- During construction work, the headway on the section between Asakusa and Tameike-sanno will be 3 minutes and the headway on the section between Aoyama-itchohome and Omote-sando will be 12 minutes.
- Please be aware that on the days of construction work, the usual last train connection with the Ginza line will not be available.
