

Get even more out of the Greater Tokyo Pass for international visitors to Japan!  
**The Autumn Maple Leaves Campaign  
extends pass to five days!**  
**October 16 (Wed.) – November 30 (Sat.), 2019**

The Greater Tokyo Pass Council, with 62 Kanto railway and bus company members, introduces the Autumn Maple Leaves Campaign. The campaign extends the period of validity for the Greater Tokyo Pass to five days for a limited time. This pass is a special ticket for international visitors to Japan. It gives users unlimited rides for three days on railways, streetcars and ordinary fixed-route buses within the permitted area of use.

The period of validity for the Greater Tokyo Pass has been extended to accommodate the many international travelers who visit Japan during the autumn foliage season. This will allow users to visit even more fascinating tourist spots in the Kanto area to experience the charms and hospitality of more of Japan.

The period of validity for the Greater Tokyo Pass purchased from October 16 (Wed.) to November 30 (Sat.), 2019 during the period of the Autumn Maple Leaves Campaign will be extended from three days to five days with no change to the sales price. (Passes purchased through Japan Holiday Travel Co., Ltd. will only be extended when redeemed at the agency's travel counter during this period.)

The Greater Tokyo Pass Council will continue to strive in the future to make it possible for international visitors to Japan to more comfortably enjoy their trips in the Kanto area. See the following pages for an overview of this campaign.

## 1. Name of Campaign

Greater Tokyo Pass Autumn Maple Leaves Campaign

## 2. Campaign Period

October 16 (Wed.) to November 30 (Sat.), 2019

## 3. Campaign Details

The period of validity for the Greater Tokyo Pass purchased during the Autumn Maple Leaves Campaign period will be extended from the normal three days to five days with no change to the sales price.

(Passes purchased through Japan Holiday Travel Co., Ltd. will only be extended when redeemed at the agency's travel counter during this period.)

## 4. Prices

7,200 yen Adults; 3,600 yen Children

\* Both are tax inclusive fares.

\* The price does not change during the Autumn Maple Leaves Campaign period.

## 5. Eligibility

International visitors to Japan only

## 6. Requirements

Sold only upon presentation of a passport to verify the purchaser is an international visitor. A signature matching the one on the passport will be required at the time of purchase. Note that purchasers may select "same day" or "following day" as the first day of use at the time of purchase.

## **7. Permitted Area of Use**

Railways and streetcars operated by 12 companies and ordinary fixed-route buses operated by 50 companies in Tokyo, Kanagawa, Chiba and Saitama

## **8. How to Use**

### ■ Railways

Use ticket at manned ticket gates. (Cannot be used at automatic ticket gates.)

### ■ Streetcars / Ordinary fixed route buses

Present ticket to attendants.

\*Passenger may be required to present passport in order to verify identity.

## **9. Refunds**

Limited to before start of use and within the period of validity. The purchase amount minus a service charge (220 yen) will be refunded at the location where the ticket was purchased.

\*Tickets redeemed at the Japan Holiday Travel counter cannot be refunded.

### Overview of “Greater Tokyo Pass” Permitted Usage

#### ■ Railways and streetcars operated by 12 companies

All lines as part of the Odakyu Line, Keio Line, Keisei Line<sup>(note)</sup>, Keikyu Line, Sotetsu Line, Seibu Line, Tokyu Line, Tokyo Metro Line, Toei Subway, Tokyo Sakura Tram (Toden Arakawa Line), Tobu Line, Minatomirai Line, and Yokohama Municipal Subway.

\*Separate fares will be charged when using limited express trains requiring a fare, reserved seating trains, etc.

Note: When including the Narita SKY ACCESS Line section (Keisei Takasago Sta. - Narita Airport Terminal 1 Sta.) on the Keisei Line, the ticket may only be used between the following stations:

(1) Traveling among all stations of the Keisei Line excluding the Hokusio Line section (between Shinshibamata Sta. - Inba Nihon-idai Sta.) and Narita - Yukawa Sta., Narita Airport Terminal 2·3 Sta. or Narita Airport Terminal 1 Sta.

(2) Traveling among all stations between Inba Nihon-idai Sta. -Narita-Yukawa Sta. - Narita Airport Terminal 2·3 Sta.

#### ■ Ordinary fixed-route buses operated by 50 companies in Tokyo, Kanagawa, Chiba, and Saitama.
