<u>Tokyo Metro Academy 2023-2024</u> "Online courses" and "Onsite training in Tokyo" held for railway officials around the world

Tokyo Metro Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Taito ward, Tokyo; President: Akiyoshi Yamamura; hereinafter referred to as "Tokyo Metro") will hold <u>Tokyo Metro Academy, "Online</u> <u>courses" and "Onsite training in Tokyo" for railway officials around the world to</u> <u>introduce its know-how and experience in railway operation to achieve safe and</u> <u>stable operation of urban railways.</u>

Tokyo Metro Academy 2023-2024 Online Courses: Starting in July 2023, 14 courses will be held sequentially. Onsite Training in Tokyo: In November 2023, face-to-face lectures and site visits will be held at Tokyo Metro. (5 consecutive days)

Eight online courses were held during Tokyo Metro Academy 2022-2023, with participants of 170 people from 14 countries, who showed great interest. In Tokyo Metro Academy 2023-2024, <u>by adding six new courses, we will hold total of 14 online courses and a new training program "Onsite training in Tokyo" that will include face-to-face lectures and site visits at Tokyo Metro.</u>

Tokyo Metro Academy will be held continuously to meet the various needs of railway officials around the world and contribute to the sustainable development of cities in the world by supporting the development of local transportation services.

(2) Overview: Participants will learn about Tokyo Metro's initiatives to achieve safe and stable transportation in operations and maintenance through face-to-face lectures and site visits, that can be used as a reference for their future railway business.

(3) Number of participants: 10 people maximum

(4) Location: Tokyo Metro facilities
