– Sales Begin August 7, 2025 –

Tokyo Metro Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Taito Ward, Tokyo; President: Akihiro Kosaka; hereinafter referred to as “Tokyo Metro”) will begin selling Tokyo Metro 24-hour tickets with a limited-time-only design of traditional Japanese patterns, starting August 7, 2025.

The design incorporates beautiful ancient Japanese motifs, such as hemp leaves, blue ocean waves, and checkerboard patterns, to create an item that adds color to a stroll through Tokyo. The two designs, available in different colors, each show a different expression, and are recommended as a collection item. After using the ticket, you can take it home as a souvenir.
